TIC TAC Mots

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Material:

- 'Tic Tac Mots' sheet or (a mini white board)
- Pencil or (a marker for white board)
- Book
- 2 or more players

How to play:

- Ask your child to pick out a book.
- Read the book once. (doing the best they can)
- Read the book a second time picking out the challenging words.
- Write the words on the paper or white board to fill in the 'Tic Tac Mots' grid.
- Ask your child to choose a word. (they have to explain a strategy they will use to try and read the word)
 - Chunking (sounds in sections of the word)
 - Look at the beginning/ending of the word (silent letters)
 - Ask if the word makes sense in the sentence
 - Decode and reread/Self-correct
 - Look at the images
 - o Find a smaller word in the big word
- If they read the word correctly they make put an X or O.
- If the word is incorrect help your child correct the word (no letter is put in the box)
- READ the book a third time (perhaps another night) to see if your child has improved their fluency and confidence ☺
